

SBJBC UK Objectives in our Articles of Association

The Company's principal objects are:

To develop and enhance relations at all levels between the business communities in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and the United Kingdom and inform the members of both the Company, and the Company's counterpart organisation in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia about the economic opportunities available with the counterpart party;

To promote, facilitate and develop private sector commerce and business activity between companies incorporated in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and the United Kingdom in cooperation with the Co-Chairs and members of the Saudi British Joint Business Council;

To communicate with the authorities in both the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and the United Kingdom with the aim of improving business to business cooperation between the two countries;

To assist in settling commercial disputes between parties from the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and the United Kingdom;

To facilitate training, technology transfer and knowledge exchange between the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and the United Kingdom;

To provide advice and counsel on issues of trade and business relations between the governments and authorities of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and the United Kingdom, and follow-up recommendations agreed by the Co-Chairs and Board members of the Saudi British Joint Business Council at the Council's bi-annual meetings;

To promote, exploit and advance commercial opportunities between the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and the United Kingdom, provide information and encourage discussions regarding:

- **Factors that may affect the growth of private sector business** in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia;
- **Initiatives that the British and Saudi Arabian governments might take** to promote private sector business and investment growth in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia;
- Promotion of business opportunities in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and the United Kingdom, **particularly for small and medium sized businesses.**

To enter into agreements with appropriate entities to advance the objects stated above.
